As we talked about, though we are not under the OT Law today, we can still learn from examples of the Old Testament. The Jews observed each and every Sabbath, because God said "observe the Sabbath," (Exodus 20:8 P 55). He did not say "observe each and every Sabbath." Yet if the Jews neglected a Sabbath they died, (Exodus 31:15 P 65). Should God's commands be followed only when we choose? Is the command to "not murder" something I should follow only sometimes?
